## WHAT OTHER SPECIAL THINGS HAVE WE ACHIEVED?

- \* Two of our pupils starred on the radio throughout Fairtrade Fortnight promoting the message to buy Fairtrade products when possible. We are now working towards a Fairtrade Award.
- \* Three of our pupils achieved their Silver awards in swimming - the highest level achieved in many years.
- \* Year 2, 5 and 6 have received Chinese culture/Mandarin lessons from Ballakermeen's Chinese teacher Loree.
- \* We had a very pleasing External Science Moderation where the moderators agreed with our assessments of pupils.
- \* Our FAST Team successfully ran our first 8 week Families and Schools Together programme for Reception and Year 1 families.
